

The powder management system OptiCenter OC02 with ultrasonic sieve US05 and the cyclone are placed within easy reach

so that color changes can be carried out quickly and cleanly. The exhaust filter was housed in a separate room, so that employees can work without noise nuisance.

Thanks to the quick color change system MagicCompact BA04 configured for manual coating, L. Schulte & Co. GmbH achieved a very high recovery rate, a higher coating quality and enhanced flexibility to handle all customer orders.
